Like the Davis ERP Boot Camp, the Birmingham Boot Camp (BBC 3.0) is based on their well-known book, "An Introduction to the Event-Related Potential Technique" (MIT Press). The first two Boot Camps (BBC 1.0, 2.0) were sell-out events and we are excited to be able to host their successor. The version at Birmingham will be a 'mini boot camp' comprised of 3 days of lectures by Prof. Luck followed by 2 days of practical ERPLAB Toolbox data-analysis activities conducted by Dr. Emily Kappenman.
